

Information on video communication

For connection via video communication, please note the following:

- **Internet:**

For good picture and sound quality, the upload/download bandwidth should be a stable 5 Mbit/second, 10 Mbit/second would be better with a stable WLAN connection. Alternatively, connect your terminal to your internet access via LAN cable.

All common browsers in their latest software version are permitted: e.g. Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Mozilla Firefox and Safari.

We also recommend that you close all other applications on your terminal device that are bandwidth- and CPU-intensive as well as e-mail programmes and messenger services to avoid distractions as well as disturbing noises in the transmission before and during your live performance.

- **VPN-Connections:**

Please note that if you connect via an active VPN connection (virtual private network), the transmission quality of your live feed may be reduced.

- **Connecting via video communication:**

On the day of the Annual General Meeting, you can use the function "digital request to speak" in the shareholder portal. You can register your request to speak under the icon "Request to speak". You can register your motions or nominations under the icon "Motions and nominations". This completes the registration of your request to speak or your motions and nominations.

After the chairman of the meeting has called your name in preparation for your live appearance, a dialog box for entering the virtual waiting room will appear in the shareholder portal. Once you have confirmed, you can enter the virtual waiting room. The next step is to check the technical functionality of your video communication. Once you have entered the virtual waiting room, you will be welcomed by our technical staff (operator) to check your video and audio quality. Please remain in the virtual waiting room until the operator contacts you.

After successfully checking your functionality, you will be connected live to the Annual General Meeting as soon as the chair of the meeting calls you by name. Once the chair of the meeting has given you the floor, you can begin your live appearance. You can continue to follow the ongoing Annual General Meeting via the stream in the shareholder portal, even while you are waiting in the virtual waiting room for your own speech.

- **Terminal/Camera position:**

The terminal used should be aligned in landscape format, stand on a stable surface and use an integrated or wired camera. You should be visible in the centre of the image and be able to look into the camera from the front. A headset usually improves the audio quality. If you receive a message from your browser at the top of the screen, give permission to access your camera and microphone. It is not necessary to install software components or apps on the terminal.

- **Lighting:**

Ensure good illumination while you are speaking, e.g. by illuminating your face with a lamp. Avoid bright light sources in your background and from the side, e.g. from windows.

- **Clothing:**

Please avoid small patterned (chequered or striped) tops to avoid flickering in the camera image.

- **Others:**

Please mute your mobile phone and do not place it in the direct vicinity your terminal device to avoid possible interference with the transmission. Always set your microphone on the terminal device to "mute" when you are not speaking.
